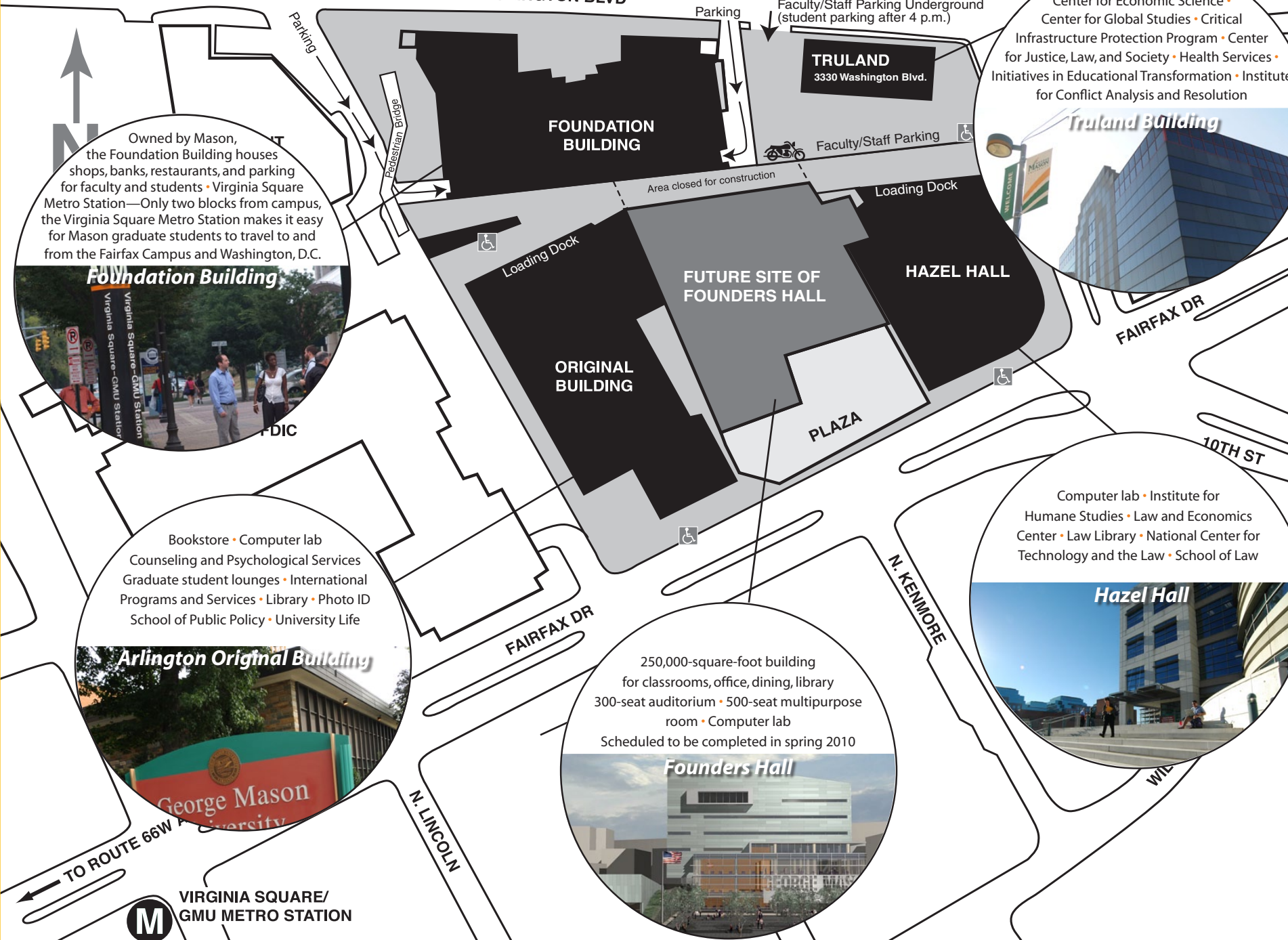

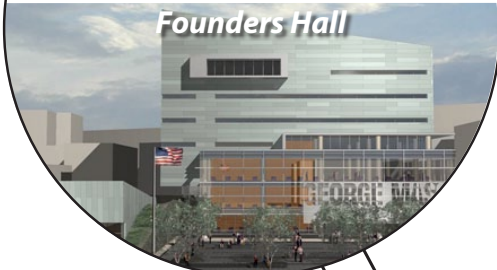
**Truland Building**
